#### Home health care firm to offer classes in May

Health Horizons, a 14-year-old home health care agency, will open Health Horizons Academy to offer vocational classes starting in May, according to company spokesman Christian Miller.

The facility will help students acquire prerequisites they need to get into college. Training primarily will be geared toward health care, but coursework will be available in math, science, computers and English.

The cost will be \$85 per credit and classes can only be taken at the Virginia Beach campus, 5716 Southern Blvd., Suite 102.

Classes will initially be offered in anatomy and physiology, biology, chemistry, composition, computers, math, microbiology, psychology and sociology, with more college-level courses to be added as the school grows, according to a statement from officials.
